

Our pick up route will remain unchanged for 2024 for all day tours and holidays (unless otherwise stated), departing from the Depot via Old Leake Church End bus stop, Butterwick Village at the Five Bells bus stop and via A52 to Boston Bus Station at the coach bay near the Len Medlock Centre.

On selected day trips we can pick up at Wainfleet Market place. If any passengers wishes to change their pick up point for any day trip or holiday this must be done at least 24 hours before departure date all changes must be via the office. We also require any mobile phone numbers along with a land line number if available, special requests should be made at time of booking.

Please note due to health and safety restrictions the driver is not responsible for the loading/unloading of any such scooter due to weight lifting restrictions.


